- Proposed Project Timeline of work required to evaluate and submit the ERC application and a projected schedule to complete the project.
- Cost Proposal that includes a percentage of award fee.

Evaluation Criteria:

- Bid will be awarded to the firm whose proposal is determined to be the most advantageous to UMA after consideration of all criteria.
- Criteria for evaluation will focus primarily on:
 - Timeline and ability to complete the project.
 - Demonstrated ability to meet the scope of work.
 - Cost proposal for project completion and detail.
