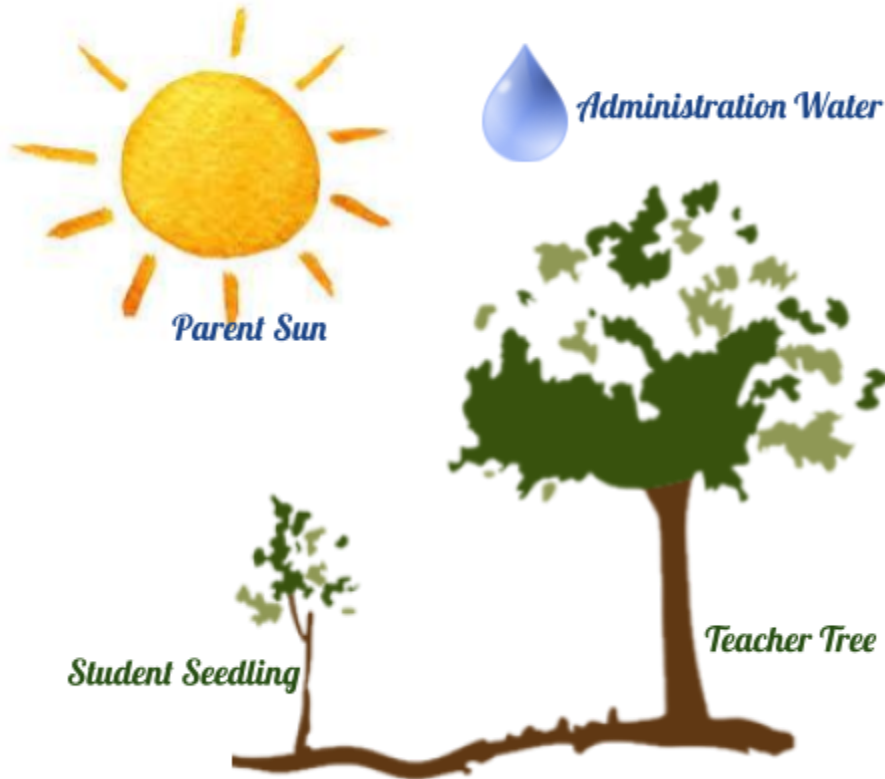

Administration Norms

Be Respectful

- Administration models respect, kindness and fair and equal treatment when interacting with staff, students and parents.
- Administration will model appropriate consequences and praise for teachers/students for the best academic outcomes.
- Administration will respect a work and family balance for both teachers and families.
- Administration will honor diversity by respecting diverse learners and cultures of our staff and families.

Be Responsible

- Administration will set clear attendance policies and work to make sure families are supported.
- Administration will ensure that STAs are completed and the curriculum is aligned with state standards and followed.
- Administration will communicate clearly with both staff and families about Greenwood expectations and activities.
- Administration will model the HEALTH values to educate staff and families on the vision and mission of Greenwood.

Be Engaged

- Administration will work with EL Education to train and educate staff and families on EL practices such as Celebrations of Learning, SLCs, High Quality Work and HEALTH values.
- Administration will support and communicate clearly about opportunities for families to be engaged in school activities and to follow student progress.
- Administration will continue to work to bring resources to Greenwood that strive for excellence.
- Administration will ensure the accomplishment of the mission of Greenwood by creating a safe, orderly, challenging, and equitable learning environment.

Be Safe

- Administration will create and comply with school policies and regulations to keep teachers, students and families safe.
- Administration will act as a mediator to resolve conflicts using restorative practices when necessary.
- Administration will create norms and encourage student behaviors which promote learning, compassion, and integrity.
- Administration will work to keep our spaces safe.

Teacher Norms

Be Respectful

- Teachers model respect, kindness and fair and equal treatment when interacting with staff, students and parents.
- Teachers will provide consequences and praise for behavior to encourage positive learning experiences for the best academic outcomes.
- Teachers are respectful of work and family balance.
- Teachers honor diversity by respecting diverse learners and cultures.

Be Responsible

- Teachers are well planned with lessons aligned to state standards for both academic & character goals.
- Weekly communication will be given about what students are learning in class and teachers display High Quality Work.
- Teachers model HEALTH values and provide families with information and good choices.
- Teachers are deliberate about creating a cohesive crew & teaching responsibility to students.

Be Engaged

- Teachers plan and carry out COLs, SLCs, and family nights.
- Teachers communicate consistently and honestly with families and students regarding student growth.
- Teachers model an interest in learning, community service and good citizenship and personal learning is valued.
- Teachers provide volunteer opportunities for parents to be engaged in student learning and in the classroom.

Be Safe

- Teachers comply with school policies, regulations and directives of the school.
- Teachers act as a mediator to resolve conflict and teach conflict resolution and restorative practices in crew.
- Teachers create norms with students in crew and hold all students accountable both inside and outside.
- Teachers monitor student safety at all times.

Student Norms

Be Respectful

- Students show respect and kindness when interacting with teachers and peers.
- Students follow the teacher's directions and show PLANT while participating in class.
- Students keep our spaces clean and follow norms.
- Students honor diversity by respecting different viewpoints.

Be Responsible

- Students will be on time and stay in class in their assigned seat.
- Complete your classwork on time and stay on task.
- Be prepared to complete your work and use the appropriate supplies.
- Have a calm body in class and use mindful strategies to engage when needed.

Be Engaged

- Students engage in their work and be prepared for SLCs, LGCs, and Celebrations of Learning to share with families.
- Students monitor their growth and use grit while completing work.
- Students use their time wisely and strive for revision and high quality work.
- Students complete assignments and projects as assigned, including homework.

Be Safe

- Students walk respectfully in the hallways and look at high quality work with their eyes, not their hands.
- Students are aware of their surroundings and follow the norms in our spaces.
- Students keep hands, feet and other objects to self.
- Students use school appropriate language and be considerate and kind to others.

Family Norms

Be Respectful

- Parents model the behavior that we want to see in our students in respecting rules and other adults.
- Parents provide consequences and praise at home to encourage positive learning experiences.
- Families participate in restorative practices and effective communication for conflict resolution
- Families practice respectful communication when talking about Greenwood with their students and others.

Be Responsible

- Parents ensure that students are here on time, stay all day and follow the Greenwood calendar for vacations and breaks.
- Parents Model the HEALTH values and participate in parent education nights.
- Parents track volunteer hours and help where they can.
- Parents attend to everyday health (mental and physical) and nutritional needs for students while working on balance.

Be Engaged

- Parents attend SLCs, Learner Goal Conferences, and Celebrations of Learning with their student.
- Parents stay current on teacher emails and have conversations with students about what they are learning.
- Parents attend an annual parent meeting either in person or online that trains on our current practices and academics.
- Parents model reading and the importance of literacy by reading as a family each night for at least 20 minutes.

Be Safe

- Parents support school wide policies designed to keep all students safe.
- Parents volunteer to help outside during recess, pick up, lunch, etc. to keep our kids safe.
- Parents will have conversations with students about how to be safe at school.
- Parents will drive appropriately at all times and watch roadways and follow signs while practicing patience.
