PER STUDENT (GRADES 7-9) ANNUAL MAXIMUM FEE AMOUNT FOR SCHOOL YEAR: \$1,845 This amount reflects the total student fees any student in grades 7-9 would be required to pay if the student participated in all courses, programs, and activities provided, sponsored, or supported by the School for students in grades 7-9 for the year.
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PER STUDENT (GRADE 6) ANNUAL MAXIMUM FEE AMOUNT FOR SCHOOL YEAR: \$1,485 This amount reflects the total student fees any student in grade 6 would be required to pay if the student participated in all after-school courses, programs, and activities provided, sponsored, or supported by the School for students in grade 6 for the year.
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PER STUDENT (GRADES REG. K-5) ANNUAL MAXIMUM FEE AMOUNT FOR SCHOOL YEAR: \$740 This amount reflects the total student fees any student in regular Kindergarten through grade 5 would be required to pay if the student participated in all after-school courses, programs, and activities provided, sponsored, or supported by the School for students in Kindergarten through grade 5 for the year.
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PER STUDENT (GRADES AUG. K-5) ANNUAL MAXIMUM FEE AMOUNT FOR SCHOOL YEAR: \$3,690 This amount reflects the total student fees any student in Augmented Kindergarten through grade 5 would be required to pay if the student participated in Augmented Kindergarten and all after-school courses, programs, and activities provided, sponsored, or supported by the School for students in Kindergarten through grade 5 for the year.
