2. Please provide information and updates from the following departments:

- a) **Business/finance/IT** – All reports are being completed on time. We are completing the yearly applications for grants as normal this time of year. The UCAP Certification report for State Charter Board has been completed.
- b) **Special Education, Business reports, Accreditation** –No new updates at this time.
- c) **Staff updates** – We hiring known positions for next school year and building our schedule that helps us know what staff hiring needs will be.
- d) **DTL Grant Report:** As part of the DTL funding we report to the board on how we have done reaching goals each year. We report that the funds obtained in this grant have all been spent on the goals approved. We have hired an Innovative Coach, Mr. Sare. He has spent his time helping us reach out goals in the grant and in our Charter. He trains teachers on using technology effectively in the classroom and in planning. We sent a team of about 10 teachers to the UCET conference this year to learn how to better incorporate technology in our instruction. This team came back and provided training to all other teachers sharing what they learned. We are building our collaborative culture at LVA on learning and sharing in this area. Mr. Sare will be conducting a Technology Needs Assessment. He has built our LearnPlatform that is a site to help us manage all digital learning tools and measure their usage and effectiveness. This grant is working really well and we will have this funding for many more years to continue growing our programs.
