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NON-PRICING POLICY STATEMENT FOR FREE AND REDUCED-PRICE MEALS

LEA NAME:

The above-named LEA has an agreement to participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), National School Breakfast Program (NSBP) and/or Special Milk Program (SMP). Program participation is recorded in CNPWeb.

Universal Free Counting and Claiming Schools accept responsibility for providing meals, snacks or milk at no charge to eligible children in the facilities under its jurisdiction, **effective SY 23-24**. This policy statement is permanent as approved.

Community Eligibility Provision Schools, Provision 2 and Provision 3 Schools (NSLP & SBP) accept responsibility for providing meals or snacks to all children at no cost in approved schools under its jurisdiction, **effective SY 23-24**.

- A. The LEA assures the Utah State Board of Education that: All eligible, enrolled children at the facilities described on the program application forms are served the same meals, at no separate charge, regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability, and that there is no discrimination during the meal service.
- B. All meals served to the children will be reported on the claim form in accordance with the method prescribed by the USBE.
- C. The LEA of a school operating under this provision agrees to pay with funds, other than federal, the differential between the per meal cost and federal reimbursement received for free, reduced-price or paid meals served to eligible children under the applicable program regulations.
