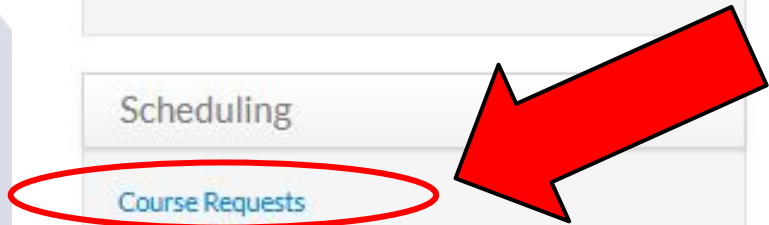

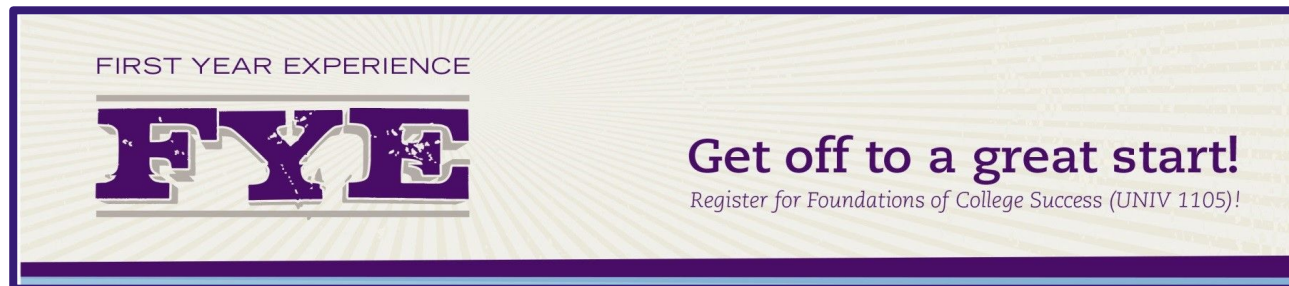

Early College Scholarship Program

- 10th (spring semester), 11th & 12th grade students can participate in the NUAMES/WSU Early College Scholarship Program
- Students must qualify, are charged tuition
- **NUAMES and WSU provides a Scholarship that apply to tuition**
- Students can access all the opportunities, course and activities provided by Weber State University
- NUAMES student who qualify are eligible for **\$2,250/semester**



How To Qualify for EC Scholarship as a 10th grader

- Student must have a GPA of 3.5
- Student must take the ACT before October
- Index score of 106 (GPA + ACT score)
- Attend an *Early College Information Session*
- In good standing and good attendance

 - Playing a sport (Enter course 75052- Magnet Class Release)
 - Medical Condition or medications
 - 504 accommodations
