Reading is an essential part of a student's academic day. It allows students the opportunity to gain knowledge, develop an imagination, and explore different ideas and topics. In every subject, including math, students are asked to read during their school day. There are seven components to literacy; oral language, phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, and writing. Each element plays a crucial role in a student's success in literacy.

I will highlight one of these elements with you. Research shows that students who have strong phonemic awareness skills are successful in early reading. Phonemic awareness is the ability to hear and manipulate sounds in spoken words. These skills are essential to learning to read in an alphabetic writing system. Without the ability to manipulate and hear sounds, phonics makes little sense to a student. Phonemic awareness is taught starting in preschool and kindergarten. Below are some activities you can do at home with your child to strengthen their phonemic awareness skills.

- Choose a three-letter word such as bat. Then have your child substitute
 different beginning sounds from the alphabet to form new words like sat,
 fat, cat, pat, hat, mat, rat.
- Ask your child to say a word without the first sound. An example would be "Say the word sit without the s." (Answer: It)
- Pick a multisyllabic word and have your student clap out the syllables. For example, experiment would be clapped out four times: ex-per-i-ment.
- Ask your child to produce a word that rhymes with another word. An
 example would be "Tell me a word that rhymes with car." (star & far) You
 could also ask your child "Which two words rhyme: stair, steel, chair?"
 (Answer: Stair & Chair)

Have fun with your child and use these activities as a game in the car or around the house. I challenge you to read with your children every night. Take an adventure as a family and go to the mystical Hogwarts Wizardry Academy by reading *Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone* by J. K. Rowling. Go on a trip with Max and see where his innovative imagination will take you by reading *Where the Wild Things Are* by Maurice Sendak. Teach them the meaning of sincere friendship by reading *Charlotte's Web* by E. B. White.

I personally enjoy the adventures I have taken with my children as we read together as a family. It allowed us to go anywhere we would like to go. A child's love for reading begins in the home.
