*NWEA is a national assessment, used since 1973, with a reliable scale built from data of 10.2 million students and 23,000 schools in 49 states.

The data clearly shows that our incoming 7th grade cadets are far below the national average with math and language arts. However, by graduation, our cadets are above average proficiency nationally, with the only exception in reading. On average, cadets that have attended UMA for three years are 3 RIT points ahead of their peers.
