
Dear Mr. Benefield,

The Utah State Board of Education has granted permission for the Sundance Mountain Charter School to move from its present location in the Alpine School District to the Wasatch School District at Soldier Hollow for the 2002-2003 school years with the following conditions:

- 1 This permission is granted for one year only.
2. The Sundance Mountain Charter School will seek a charter from the Wasatch School Board, and if a charter is not granted, the existing State Board Charter will expire at the end of the 2002-2003 school year.
3. If the Wasatch School Board does not grant the school a charter, the Sundance Mountain Charter School may apply to the State Board for a new charter as provided in R277-470.


Dear Ms. Johnson,






