

STANDARD 1 – Comprehensive Guidance Program

DEFINITION:

The Comprehensive Guidance Program is a tool to guide how guidance services will be implemented at Hawthorn Academy to maximize student potential in our school. The emphasis is to address the needs of all students. The four major components of Hawthorn Academy's Comprehensive Guidance Program are: guidance curriculum, responsive services, individual planning, and system support.

Guidance Curriculum is designed to address competencies to be developed by all students and implemented through classroom and group activities. Individual Planning involves students, their parents, and school counselor in a planning process that guides and monitors the students' personal/social, educational, and career development (the SEOP).

Responsive Services focuses on providing help to students who face obstacles that interfere with personal/social, education, or career development through prevention and intervention programs, counseling, consultation, and referral. System Support includes the management of activities that establish, maintain, and enhance the total guidance program and support the total school program.

BOARD APPROVAL:

The Hawthorn Academy Charter School Board has adopted the Comprehensive Guidance Program, K-9 as our school's counseling program. As part of this, our school personnel understands that the board adopting the Comprehensive Guidance Program as the means for delivering school counseling to students requires support at the board level, for counselor, to highly implement the model.
