Policy: Enrollment and Lottery Policy

PURPOSE

To provide guidelines on appropriate procedures on enrollment and lottery processes.

POLICY

In regards to applications, enrollment, and lottery procedures, Hawthorn Academy (the "School") will follow all state and federal laws and guidelines.

Past Disciplinary Issues

Any student seeking enrollment in the School who was suspended from another school for disciplinary reasons within the previous twelve (12) months will not be admitted to the School until a thorough review of the student's prior conduct is evaluated by the administration. In order to comply with Utah law and the School's Safe Schools Policy, any student seeking admission to the School who has been convicted of drug, alcohol, theft or other serious infraction of the law will be subject to the School's discipline provisions, which may include non-admission to the School. Parents of students seeking admission to the School must disclose to the School information about past disciplinary actions and any of the foregoing convictions. If this information is not disclosed in connection with a student's application for enrollment in the School and is discovered after the student is enrolled in the School, the student will be immediately suspended until the administration investigates the matter and reaches a final disciplinary decision in accordance with School policy.
