

Procedures for Advancing students in Math

1. Students/Parents who are petitioning to be advanced to the next grade level in math will complete the following to determine if they have the comprehension of math concepts and skills necessary to be successful at the next level:
 - a. Complete the End of Level test for the grade in which they are currently registered.
 - b. Complete the end of unit tests for units covered in the grade to which they wish to advance.
 - c. Complete an oral exam with the math teacher in the next grade level to determine if they understand “why” they used the skills/formulas they did on a random sampling of problems on the assessments.
 - d. Complete 80% of ALEKS at grade level and achieve 90% proficiency on skills practiced
 - e. Assessments will be administered and graded by the teacher who is instructing at the level of the tests (e.g., current grade level end of year test by current teacher, next grade level unit tests will be corrected by the teacher the next grade level).
2. Counselor will create a CCR for each student indicating that they are an ‘early graduate’
 - a. This is as per state law
