Meals Available for Children during COVID-19 School Closures

Hawthorn Academy is participating in the Seamless Summer Option or Summer Food Service Program. Meals will be provided to all children without charge and are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service. Meals will be Limited to Enrolled at Students of Hawthorn Academy, and will be provided, at a first come, first serve basis, at the sites and times as follows:

West Jordan Curbside for 5-day a week Distant
Learners 11:15-11:45
West Jordan Grab & GO Lunches for A&B
Students at end of day from 2:30pm-3PM*

Due to the COVID public health emergency this site is operating under COVID-19: Child Nutrition Response #52, Seamless Summer Option, Nationwide Waiver to Extend Area Eligibility Waivers – extension 2. This option was chosen because of the amount of staffing, the safety of Food Service Workers, and ability to purchase food types needed.
