Bridge Elementary Optional Online Learning Procedures for 2020-2021 School Year

Bridge Elementary offers an optional online learning program for the 2020-2021 school year for students who are unable to attend school due to COVID19 concerns. Online learning at Bridge is asynchronous online. Asynchronous means instruction is not delivered at set meeting times/days though students must login five days each week to receive attendance credit. Bridge Elementary will not provide devices for students to complete online instruction.

REGISTRATION

Students must enroll in online learning prior to the beginning of each term and remain **enrolled for the entire term**. Students who wish to return to traditional, in-person schooling may do so at the beginning of a term. Please see deadlines below.

INSTRUCTION

Instruction is facilitated by a licensed teacher and may include a variety of activities such as computer assisted instruction and lessons recorded during live instruction for students to view at a later date or time.

Students in the online program may attend Bridge After-School Enrichment (BASE). Online students will complete the same registration process for BASE classes as traditional students. To learn more about BASE please see our website at https://www.bridgecharter.org/b-a-s-e

GRADING

The online facilitator provides grades for all students. Student grades are accessed through ASPIRE.

ASSESSMENT

Students in Kindergarten must complete KEEP testing twice each year. Students in grades K-6 will participate in Acadience reading testing three times yearly. Students in grades 3-6 will participate in RISE end of year testing in the Spring. The online teacher coordinates assessment with parents. All assessment must be completed in-person at the school.

ATTENDANCE

Students are required to login and complete, at minimum, their Imagine Learning sessions for Language Arts and Math five days a week. Each day of completion equals attendance for one school day. Imagine Learning sessions are a minimum of 30 minutes for each subject.
