Any high school junior who plans to enroll in college in the fall of 2022 and is an American citizen or legal permanent resident is eligible to apply (current high school seniors are not eligible to apply). 6. **CE Courses for Next Semester:** Next semester through Snow College IVC (interactive Video Conferencing) we will be offering the classes listed below.
