# INTENT TO RETURN TO BRIDGE




On Friday we sent a reminder email for students in grades K-5 who have not registered for next school year or who have not completed the "will not be returning" form. This is an incredibly important process as it not only holds your child's spot at Bridge for next school year, but it also allows us to know exactly how many spots we will have open for the lottery. Please check your email for information about completing the registration process. The deadline to register for next school year is December 31, 2020. Our lottery will open January 18, 2021 for all incoming siblings, this includes kindergarten students and the general public. Remember, siblings have FIRST priority in the lottery. 

This month during Visible Learning, students learned about the importance of Flexibility. This picture is one of the activities students completed. Please have your students practice the following "I Will..." statements.


- I will anticipate change.

- I will do what is right.





