How funds were used and what was accomplished.

### **SJ**

#### Goal

Teachers will learn how to increase student learning through use of engagement strategies and increased rigor activities through training by Innovations Educational Consulting and tracking through CoachUp Instructional Database .

Students benefited in that they were consistently engaged more in the learning process and teachers were constantly checking for understanding. Once they understood where students were in their learning they could adjust instruction and engage students in learning.

#### Goal

Increase the percent of students' proficiency on ELA by increasing the amount of time that students are in class receiving instruction.

Students benefited by being in class more and not out of the classroom due to discipline issues.

#### Goal

Increase student learning on computer science concepts and increase student keyboarding skills.

Students benefited by increased skills in typing in order to write without keyboarding slowing down their ability to express their knowledge.

#### Goal

Student learning on core concepts will increase through integration of technology in their Learning. Students benefited through better utilization of online learning programs that supported the skills and knowledge base of students. Once we were 100% online due to COVID, it helped students navigate the learning platforms and helped the school plan for the 2020-21 school year where some students could not attend in person and needed to learn online.
