If your cadet was never issued uniforms and plans to return to in-person school for the next term, we will be issuing uniforms Jan 19 and 20.

Other notes:

1. We will continue COVID testing of all cadets who participate in extracurricular activities – including Team Time (not study halls) every two weeks to ensure they are all current. Parents are welcome to have their cadets tested off-site if they prefer –with proof of a negative test,

cadets will be cleared for participation for two weeks following that test date. With proof of a positive test, cadets will be cleared for participation for 90 days following their test date.

Some of our Team Time offerings and days will change with the new term. I will be emailing those out to cadets as soon as they are finalized and they will need to sign up with the instructor for any they plan to attend.

- The Amazon Future Engineer Scholarship awards \$40k for college and an internship with Amazon. You must be a senior planning to major in Computer Science to apply:

- **Coolidge Scholarship (Juniors):** The Coolidge Scholarship is a full-ride, four-year, merit scholarship. Any high school junior who plans to enroll in college in the fall of 2022 and is an American citizen or legal permanent resident is eligible to apply.
- **USCA Scholarship:** Applications are due Jan 15 for this \$500 scholarship awarded based on an essay about a school counselor who has helped you. Cadets can apply here: http://www.utschoolcounselor.org/counselor-recognition.html.
- The Utah Promise Scholarship is a needs based scholarship available at all USHE institutions (all Utah tax payer funded colleges). Just google Utah Promise and the college of your choice.

- Scholarships for Engineering and Architecture-Bound Students: High school seniors who plan to pursue an ABET (Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology) accredited engineering degree, a NAAB (National Architectural Accreditation Board) architecture degree, or a Construction Management degree can apply for an \$1,800 college scholarship. - 6. **Applications for Academy Summer Seminars are open now** or will open soon. These are open to Juniors only and your best chance to get a slot is to apply early!

Air Force is open now and closes Jan 15. The application is at this link: https://www.academyadmissions.com/prepare/high-school/summer-seminar/.

Navy opens on January 4 and closes as soon as it is filled, which typically is within a couple of weeks.

Army applications will open Jan 15 and close on March 15.

Remember, if you can't find the link, just google the name of the academy and the words "summer seminar."

- 7. The **Air Force ROTC Scholarships and Admissions Advisor** for Utah and Wyoming is wrapping up the scholarship window for seniors and is now reaching out to current juniors and other underclassmen who want information about Air Force ROTC and going to the Air Force Academy as well as advice on applying and preparing for college. There are information sessions throughout January that cover those three topics that students can attend if they are interested! Information on the sessions is available here. Students can register by clicking on the dates or scanning the QR code.
- 8. UMA is looking for parents who can help with sewing projects. We need people who can sew on patches, hem pants, and also a talented individual who can do more extensive alterations to merge a couple of uniforms into a larger size. If you can help, please contact SMSgt Mario Reeve at mreeve@utahmilitaryacademy.org. Alterations are a reimbursable expense under the JROTC program so we are able to pay a small fee for your services.
- 9. We will administer the ACT to juniors free of charge March 17 at the school. Juniors who want to take the test more than once before the end of the academic year or any cadet who is not a junior, but wants to take the test should go to ACT.org to schedule. The next available test is Feb 6 and they must register no later than Jan 8. It is especially important for cadets hoping for a scholarship or admission to an Academy to take the ACT multiple times to ensure the best score possible. There are free study materials and courses to help at march2success.com.
- 10. Believe it or not, it's time for us to begin planning for NEXT SCHOOL YEAR! We sent a text earlier in the week with a link to our **'intent to return'** document. If you haven't completed that yet, please take a moment to do so. You can <u>CLICK HERE</u> for the link. If we don't have this form completed by Feb 1st, you will not receive the registration information for next year. Thanks so much for getting this completed as soon as possible.
- 11. We will be filling the top cadet wing leadership positions soon including the selection of a new Wing Commander! Cadets will hold these positions from the time they are filled until Jan 2021. Other positions will be filled before the end of the year and begin in the fall semester.
