

## **COVID 19 Updates**

## **Vaccine Distribution**

- CNS will be preforming weekly clinics located at central public-school locations to administer vaccines to school staff
- Cory Fowlks is the program director who will be over seeing the vaccine distribution in all school K-12 in SL and Utah Counties
- Every Tuesday morning, school POC's will receive a sign-up link from Cory with slots for vaccine administration
- This link is for all private/ charter schools in Utah County
- Vaccine allocation is based on student populations between public and private/ charter schools (7% go to you)
- School POC's will be responsible for forwarding this link to their school staff who are interested in receiving the vaccine
- There are limited spots available every week
- Please allow staff that are 65+, have underlying health conditions, or are in high exposure settings to receive the vaccine first
- Slots will fill up quickly, if there are no slots left, please wait till next week to try for a sign up again
- Once a staff member has signed up, they will attend a clinic on a Friday or Saturday of that same week to receive the vaccine
- You will receive email updates with further information from CNS
- CNS anticipates all those who want the vaccine will have their first dose with in the next 4 to 6 weeks (by the end of February)
- CNS anticipates all willing school staff will be fully vaccinated in the next 10 weeks
