




Additionally, Valentine's Day is on a Saturday this year making it a great time to celebrate with the family. The previous Friday (February 12) and the following Monday (February 15) are also *no school* days.



Our model includes small group learning for reading and math, computer aided instruction in language arts and math, and stations in which students work independently or collaboratively to complete work aligned with core standards and their personalized learning plan (grade 1 - 6). The pictures below show math CAIS, small group reading in a 4th grade classroom, and a math station.







WHOLE GROUP LEARNING

Another part of our model is whole group learning using Heggerty (phonemic awareness for grades K-2) and Vocabulary Surge (grades 3-6). This is a picture of our 1st graders working on Heggerty in the KIVA. Because this is a phonemic awareness program and seeing and hearing the sounds is critical to the



learning, Mrs. Archuleta wears a face shield so students can see her mouth form the sounds. She is also using our amazing Audio Enhancement system which helps teachers provide crystal clear instruction through a state-of-the-art amplification system.
