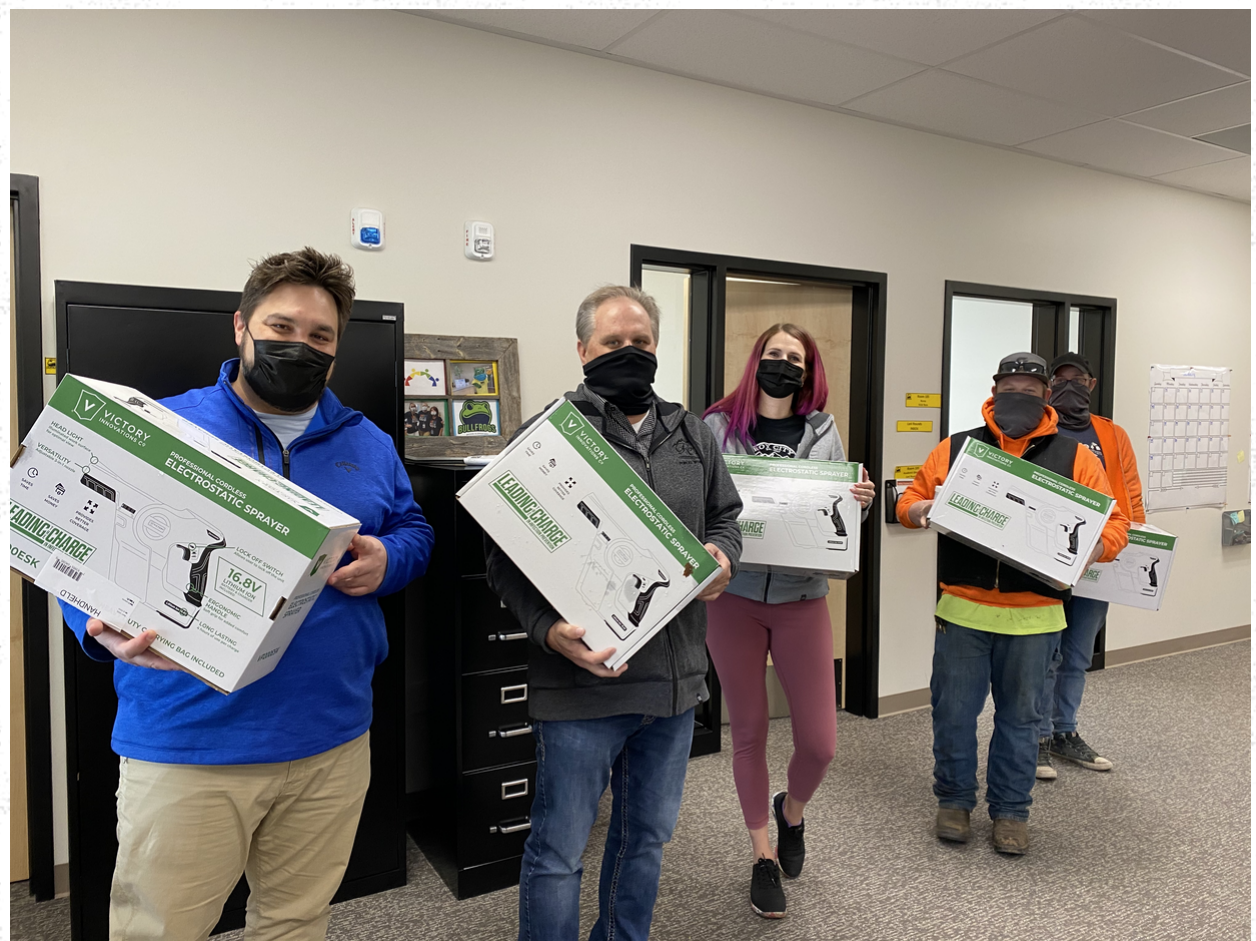


## REMEMBER - NO SCHOOL ON THURSDAY OR FRIDAY

4. ALL individuals must sanitize upon entry to the school and entry to the classroom.



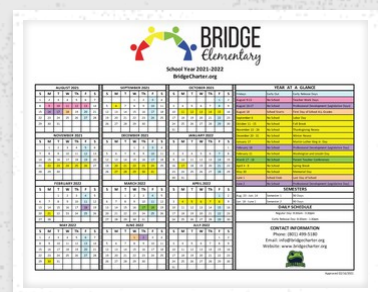
## DONATION FROM ROY CITY

Thank you again for ALL of your input via the calendar survey a few months ago. The calendar has now been approved by the Bridge Board. This calendar was created based on the majority



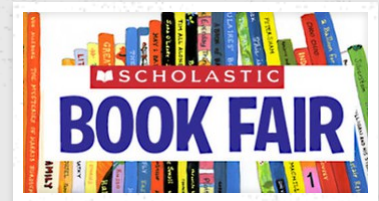


of survey responses received. The most notable change from the current year is short day has been moved to Friday. School starts August 18 and ALL K-6 students begin school on that day.

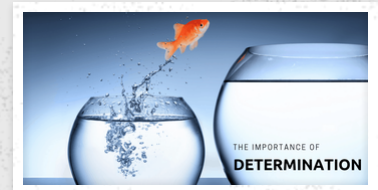

## VISIBLE LEARNING - DETERMINATION



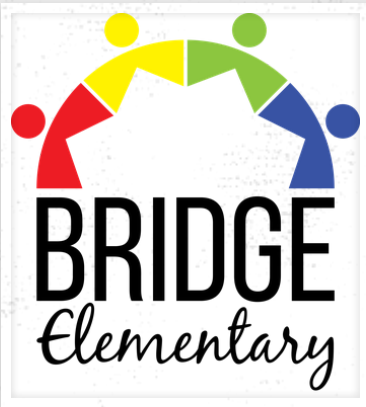
This month during Visible Learning, students are learning about the importance of Determination - "Overcoming obstacles to meet my goals."
