**Walking Routes**

**Section 1 (Northeast of Hawthorn Academy)**

If you live in section 1, parents should provide transportation to the school as crossing 9000 South is too dangerous.

**Section 2 (Northwest of Hawthorn Academy)**

If you live in section 2, parents should provide transportation to the school as crossing 9000 South is too dangerous.

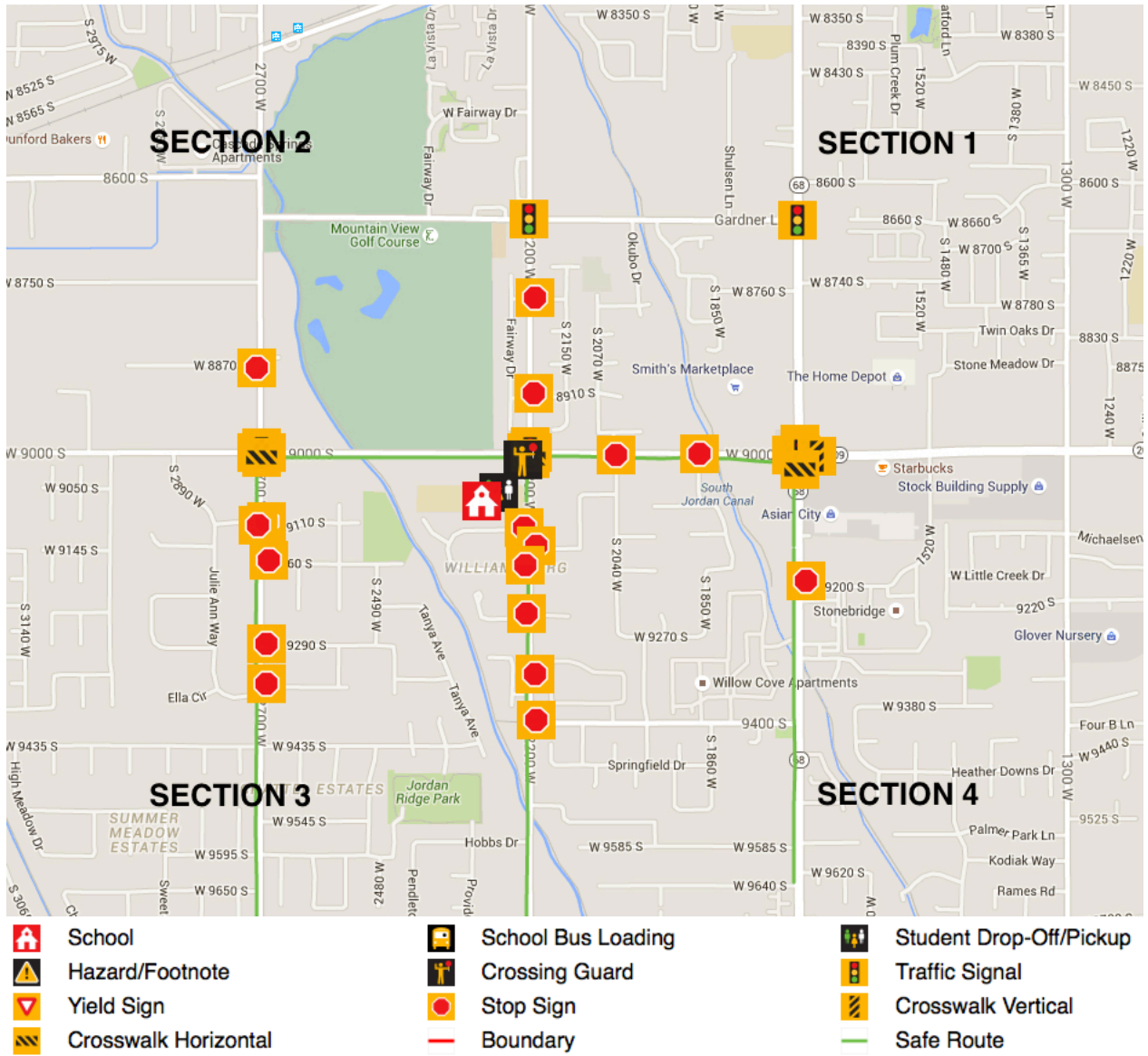
**Section 3 (Southwest of Hawthorn Academy)**

If you live in section 3, walk towards 2700 West while staying on the west side of 2700 South and cross on the south side at the intersection of 9000 South. Students will stay on the south side of 9000 South walking East on the sidewalk until reaching 2200 West where they will turn South on said road. Students will use the sidewalks walking South on 2200 West until they reach the crosswalk at the South end of the Hawthorn Academy property.

Hawthorn Academy will provide assistance for students walking across the North entrance and the South exit of the school property

**Section 4 (Southeast of Hawthorn Academy)**

If you live in section 4 walk on Redwood Rd staying on the West side of the street. Turn westbound on 9000 South staying on the South side of the street. Students will walk west on sidewalks on 9000 South to 2200 West and will cross at the intersection of 9000 South and 2200 West with the appropriate green light. If students are too young to follow the light, parents should provide transportation or walk with their students.

## **Student Drop-off Procedures**

Doors will open at 8:05 every morning. Please do not drop off students any earlier. However, please get your students here early enough to allow them to get to their class and are not tardy. Middle school students who are dropped off at 8:05 am will be permitted to go to their 1st period teacher's class. Kindergarten students will also be permitted to go to their teacher's class. Elementary students grades 1-6 will go to the gym until 8:25 am and will then be released to go to their homeroom class at 8:25 am.

### **Drop-off (AM)**

- Middle School starts at 8:20 am (Monday – Friday)
- Elementary starts at 8:30 am (Monday – Friday)

Cars will enter the school parking lot from 2200 west through the north entrance to the parking lot. Both entrance lanes will be accessible and two lanes of cars will move forward. Please do not allow your student(s) to exit the vehicle unless they are in an unloading zone. Make sure that your students are ready to exit your car once within the unloading zone so as to not hold the cars behind you. Cars using the outside lane will exit their students to the right or curbside.

Cars using the inside lane will have their students exit on the left and go to the crosswalk near the flagpole – students will wait until they are crossed by a staff member or volunteer. Please follow the direction of the staff member or volunteers. The entrance lane closest to the neighborhood (on the south entrance/exit) will be blocked off making it an exit only during the morning hours. No students will be permitted to cross the parking lot unless accompanied by an adult. Walking students will use the cross walk located along the south wall of the parking lot.

## **Student Pick-up Procedures**

### **Pick-up (PM)**

- Elementary ends at 3:00 pm (Monday – Thursday)
- Elementary ends at 1:00 pm on Fridays
- Middle School ends at 3:10 pm (Monday – Thursday)
- Middle School ends at 1:10 pm on Fridays

The north parking lot entrance will be blocked off with cones except for day care vans and emergency vehicles who will be allowed to enter as needed. All parents will enter the south side of the parking lot and will enter into one of 10 “stacking” or “queue” lanes. Each stacking lane will accommodate approximately 6-7 cars (65 total) and approximately 18-20 cars in the waiting line. Cars will need to have their carpool tag hanging from the rear-view mirror. Cars will be directed and sent into the waiting line from each stacking lane and will be motioned forward by the school staff/parent volunteer. Carpool

numbers will be radioed to the school and students will be dismissed from their classrooms to go to the front entrance of the school.

Please do not allow your student(s) to enter the vehicle unless they are in a loading zone.

Please note that the exit onto 2200 West will be a **RIGHT TURN ONLY** during the afternoon pick-up times (2:50 – 3:30 pm).

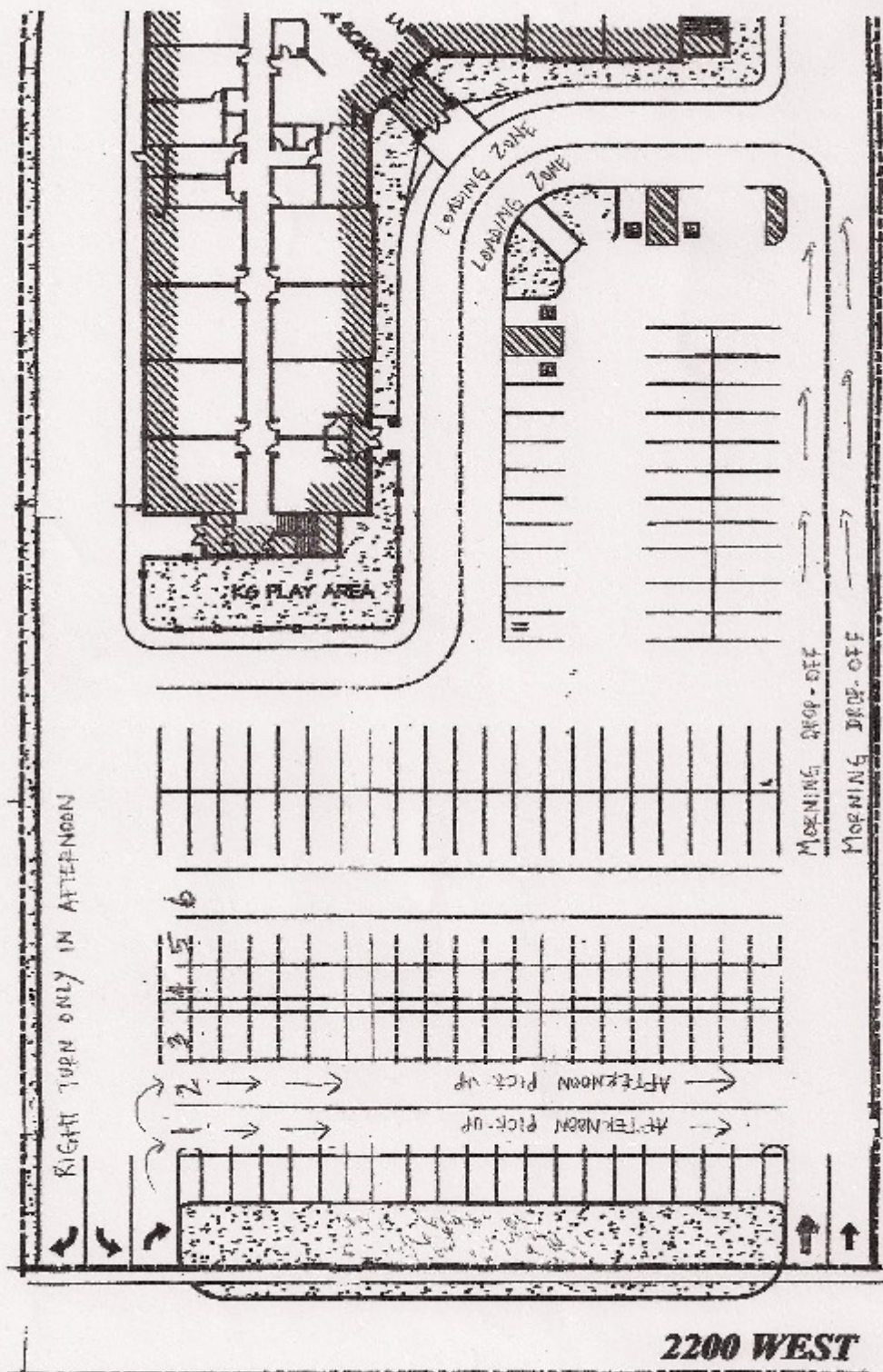
Parents and carpools that only have elementary students are encouraged to come to the school at 3:00 pm to pick up their students. Parents and carpools that have only middle school students or both middle school and elementary students are encouraged to come to the school after 3:10 pm to pick up students. Elementary students who have middle school students in their carpools will remain in their classroom and be dismissed at 3:10 to come outside and wait for their carpool. Elementary walking students will be dismissed at 3:07 pm and middle school walking students will be dismissed at 3:10 pm. All walking students are to use the designated crosswalks while on school property and are only to cross 2200 west at 9000 South with the aid of the city crossing guards. Students and parents should not cross 2200 west unless in a designated cross walk.

\*\*Please note: The parking lot has been re-stripped for afternoon pick-up. Each lane is numbered. Lanes 1 – 7 are for elementary carpools with lanes 9 and 10 being for carpools that have a middle school student. Thank you for all of your help in making this process flow smoothly. Lane 8 is left open as the fast lane (for emergency vehicles, for after school activity instructors, coaches, teachers and parents who need to pick up students early once stacking lanes are full). Please do not use lane 8 to bypass the pick-up procedure Hawthorn has in place.

**\*\*Please note that no parking or waiting is allowed on 2200 West, as per the posted signs\*\***

**\*\*Please note there is no parking or waiting in Williamsberg Circle from 7:00 – 9:00 am and 2:00 – 5:00 pm as per the posted signs\*\***
