


FIRE DRILL ON TUESDAY

We get to have our FIRST "evacuate the building" fire drill on Tuesday, March 16. Up until now, teachers have been provided training on what would happen during a drill and they shared this information with students, but because of COVID we have not been allowed to evacuate the building.



This fire drill will evacuate students from the building using a pre-arranged schedule designed to reduce the amount of close contact that would normally occur during a whole school evacuation. We will NOT be pulling the fire alarm, but instead will make an announcement for each grade level following the schedule below.

If you come to the school to check out a child, please be patient during this time.

9:00 - 9:15 = Kindergarten, grades 5/6 and kitchen staff

9:20 - 9:35 = Grades 1, 3 and custodial staff

9:40 - 9:55 = Grades 2, office and specialists

10:00 - 10:15 = Grade 4, SpED and other non-assigned staff

NOTE - students will NOT have morning recess on Tuesday. Lunch recess will be at the regular time.


VISIBLE LEARNING - DETERMINATION
