The Bridge Elementary campus is located at approximately 4850 South Midland Drive in Roy. The elementary will serve approximately 525 students in grades K-6.

Most students will arrive and depart in carpools or guardian vehicles. Patrons are asked to follow the schools designated Drop Off and Pick Up procedures to ensure student safety and the efficiency of traffic flow through the area.

Traffic Controls

There are various stop, yield, and traffic signals throughout the neighboring subdivisions and access routes. Parents who choose to allow their students to walk or bike to and from school will assume responsibility for all risks involved. Travelers should obey all traffic lights, laws, signs, and signals and cross carefully and legally to enter and exit school grounds.

Traffic lights exist on 4800 South and 3500 West, and 5600 South and 3500 West.

Hazards and Sidewalks

Parents and students who decide to walk or bike to and from school should follow the safest routes possible using sidewalks or crosswalks to reach nearby residential neighborhoods. Parents who choose to allow their students to walk or bike to school are encouraged to travel these routes with their children to determine the safest route possible.

Bridge Elementary recommends sidewalk/pedestrian traffic improvements in the following areas:

- *South side of 4800 south crossing the canal*
- *East and west sides of the canal on Midland*

School Crosswalk

Bridge Elementary recommends school crosswalk improvements in the following areas:

- *It is recommended that a crosswalk be placed in to the west of the school along Midland so that students from west and south of the school can cross and access the building safely.*
- *It is recommended a crossing guard be placed at the intersection of 4800 S and 3500 W.*

Walking and Biking Routes

Students riding their bicycles should stay on the extreme far right of the road, when necessary, allowing vehicle traffic the right of way as much as possible. Where available, students should ride on sidewalks as much as possible.

Below are the current walking and biking routes:

North:

When leaving the school, students living north of the 4800 South should walk east to the intersection of 3500 W. and 4800 S. using the traffic and pedestrian controls to cross to the appropriate street and proceed with caution. NOTE: there is no safe crossing from the east side of 3500 W to the west side of 3500 W north of the aforementioned intersection.

South:

When leaving the school, students should travel south along Midland, but should avoid crossing the canal bridge on Midland as there is no route for pedestrian traffic. Students should then head east on 4850 S to access their neighborhood road south of the school. For those who reside south and west of the school, improvements along 4800 S. and Midland are required before pedestrian traffic is safe.

East:

When leaving the school, students should travel north on Midland to 4800 south, turn right and walk toward the intersection of 3500 W. and 4800 S. Students should use the traffic and pedestrian controls to cross 3500 W. and 4800 S. to access a safe sidewalk route to the east of the school. NOTE: Caution should be used to cross the train tracks at approximately 2700 W. and 4800 S.

West:

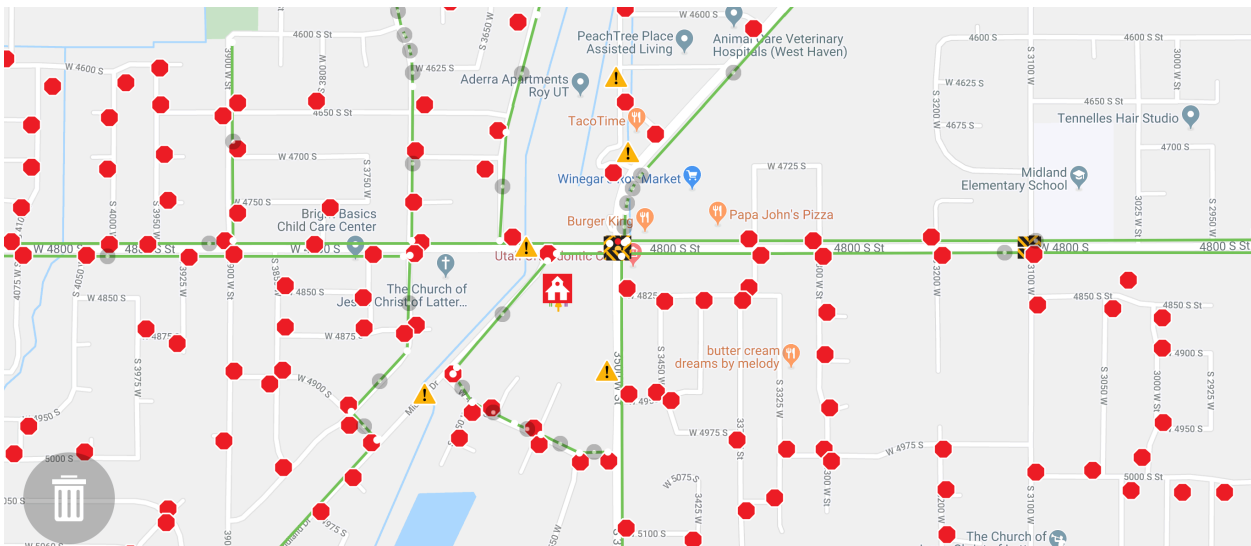
Improvements along 4800 S. and Midland are required for students living west of the school and south of Midland before pedestrian traffic is safe. For those living west of the school and north of 4800 S, students leaving the school should first go north on Midland, turn right and walk toward the intersection of 3500 W. and 4800 S. Students should use the traffic and pedestrian controls to cross 3500 W. and 4800 S. to access a safe sidewalk route and their residence.

Overview













Based on the student population and the residential locations within a mile radius, it is estimated 25% or more of Bridge Elementary students will walk or bike to and from school. Students that walk or bike are encouraged to follow the below maps outlined safe walking routes and always use the sidewalk.

Minus the traveling routes outlined above, the school advises against students walking or biking to and from school, especially during heavy traffic time periods on the roadway.

These routes are for the immediate area around Bridge Elementary and are not exhaustive. Please contact the school for additional information regarding safe traveling routes.
