May 19 - Kindergarten Round Up for 2021-2022 students


May 24 - KEEP Kindergarten end of year assessment begins

 healthy behaviors.




IMAGINE LEARNING ACCESS UNTIL JULY 30

We just received word from our vendor that our students will have access to Imagine Learning, until July 30! Imagine will also have a fun math challenge during the summer in which students can win awesome prizes just by completing lessons.



DIBELS TESTING

Next week we will complete our DIBELS testing but we are TOO excited to wait and share our kindergarten results! (The only grade that has completed all testing.) In ALL of my educational career I have never seen this kind of growth in kindergarten reading. At the beginning of the year only 47% of our kindergarten students were at grade level (blue and green). With some COVID hiccups, quarantines and soft closure, our scores dipped a little at the middle of the year, BUT with no unplanned breaks the scores increased substantially. Now, 75% of our kindergarten kiddos are at grade level according to DIBELS. This is a 28% growth! Our kinder teachers, paras and kids are the BEST!



DRESS CODE REMINDERS

As warm weather is upon us please remember we still have a dress code even on dress down days:

- Closed toed shoes only NO flip flops or sandals.
- Skirts, skorts, shorts, and dresses must be no shorter than
 4" above the knee unless leggings or tights are worn underneath (leggings or tights must be black or white only)
- Shirts must have a sleeve that is at least 3" wide (tank tops and spaghetti strap tops not allowed) and must be long enough that the belly or midriff are not visible.
