
As always, thank you for entrusting Bridge with your children's education.

## FIELD DAY - PLEASE READ

We are SUPER excited for our "We Opened a New School and Survived a Pandemic" Field Day on June 3, the last day of school. From 9:00 am - 2:00 pm, students will rotate through the many different activities (45 minute rotations). Teachers and para-educators will accompany the students for each rotation.



#### **SUN SAFETY**

Except for the magician and movie, students WILL be outside all day. We will have water stations available throughout the playground area. Each student will have a ziplock bag with their name on it. The bag will contain cups for the water stations and tickets for the games. This is a great place for the kids to keep a small bottle of sunscreen. Please make sure your students have applied sunscreen BEFORE coming to school, but also, please send them with a small, personal bottle they can use during the day. Teachers will encourage students to apply sunscreen throughout the day.

Students can wear hats and are encouraged to wear clothing that is appropriate for the weather on Thursday. Currently the news reports it will be 90F and sunny on Thursday. Check the weather Thursday morning and have your child dress accordingly. The "no flip flops or sandals" rule STILL applies on Field Day - this is for your child's safety.

## DRESS CODE REMINDERS
