


Tasting Realistic Fiction

Tasting Historical Fiction

A story set in the past about historical events but with fictional characters.

Would you have liked to live in the past?






Tasting Science Fiction

A story based on an imaginary future when technology and science have advanced.

Sometimes set in outer space and often involves robots or artificial intelligence.





Tasting Fantasy Fiction

A story that cannot really happen and may include talking objects, magical powers, talking animals, wizards, witches, and more.






Tasting Mystery Fiction

A story based on a puzzling event. Usually suspenseful and including some kind of detective work.

Can you solve the mystery?





Tasting Adventure Fiction

A story based on events that happen outside of ordinary life, usually putting the character in danger.

What would you do on an adventure?






Tasting Thriller Fiction

A story based on a suspenseful situation, usually set in the modern day. These books might make you afraid of the dark!

May also be known as horror or scary.






Tasting Classic Fiction

A story that has stood the test of time and impacted society in a powerful way.

Have you seen these stories in movies?





Tasting Literary Non-Fiction

A factually accurate story using literary styles and techniques. It reads just like a fiction book, but is true. These could include biographies or stories about events.






Tasting Biography

A written account of someone's entire life.

A memoir is a snippet of events in a person's life.

An autobiography is a book written about the author by the author.





Tasting **Humor**

A story to make readers laugh. Events or characters are used in unique ways. The setting may be realistic or may not exist. May include irony or puns.





Tasting Traditional Literature

A story passed orally with a universal theme for clearly defined characters. Includes fairy tales, fables, myths, legends, tall tales, folklore, nursery rhymes, proverbs, and animal tales.





Tasting Poetry

Follows pre-determined structure including stanzas and form. They also follow rhyme and rhythm and meter - or nothing at all. There are a variety of types of poetry.
