Tops	<p>Any solid color polo or button down with sleeves and collar. Long or short sleeved. Sleeves and collar must be same color as shirt. Logo must be smaller than a quarter.</p> <p>Undershirts must be school approved colors or white.</p>	Elementary White, pink, navy or light blue	MS Any solid color NOT elementary.
Bottoms	<p>Professional casual slacks, pants, shorts, skorts or jumpers.</p> <p>-Color: Tan, black, navy blue</p> <p>-Fit: Must sit at natural waistline and not show underwear.</p> <p>-Style and fabric: Must be hemmed, and free from rips or tears.</p>	<p>No neon, florescent or metallic or denim, or “heather” colors.</p> <p>No excessively baggy or too tight. No shorter than 4” above the knee when standing. No jogging pants or sweat pants. NO athletic shorts or yoga pants unless in PE.</p>	
Socks , Leggings and Shoes	<p>Shoes: any close-toed shoe. Shoe choices must be appropriate for the activities of the day and help a student remain safe while participating.</p> <p>Socks must be worn.</p> <p>Socks worn with shorts, skirts, skorts or jumpers must be solid color and non distracting.</p> <p>Leggings, tights or shorts must be worn underneath skorts, skirt or jumper.</p>	<p>No lights or wheels on shoes.</p> <p>No flip flops, slippers, sandals or backless shoes</p> <p>Solid white, navy or black leggings /tights only</p> <p>MS girls may wear nylons with skirts/dresses.</p>	
In class wear: hoodies and cardigans	<p>Hoodies, cardigans, sweaters or vests</p> <p>Must be solid color in grade-approved colors.</p> <p>Middle school students must wear Lakeview approved hoodies.</p> <p>Sports team members may wear approved team jackets.</p>	<p>No :</p> <p>-Jean/denim jackets</p> <p>-pull-over sweatshirts/hoodies</p> <p>-lightweight jackets or windbreakers</p> <p>-blankets used as a jacket</p>	
Hats, Accessories and Hair	<p>Hair must be non-distracting in color and style.</p> <p>Any un-natural / hair coloring not permitted, to include hair extensions or clip in braids.</p> <p>Accessories must be non-distracting in size and style.</p>	<p>No hats or sunglasses in the building.</p> <p>Boys may not wear earrings.</p> <p>No visible tattoos (temporary or permanent) or body piercings.</p> <p>No excessive/distracting jewelry.</p>	
Pride Land Dress Prideland Days are every Friday and other days as designated.	<p>School approved t-shirts</p> <p>Solid blue jeans or denim shorts</p> <p>Students may also wear regular school bottoms or tops.</p>	<p>No ripped or torn jeans.</p> <p>Pants, etc. must be hemmed</p> <p>No overalls or denim jumpers</p>	

Dress Down Days	<p>Students may wear appropriate everyday clothes on dress-down days.</p> <p>School approved shoes only.</p>	<p>No: Pajamas Gang colors/symbols Costumes Mesh, see-through, torn or ripped Bare midriff or shoulders Flip-flops, sunglasses or hats</p>
Sports Team Dress	<p>Home Game Day: dress up: shirts/ties for men Dresses/skirts/dress slacks for ladies</p> <p>Away Game Day: team shirt/jacket and blue jeans or school approved bottoms.</p>	No denim jackets.
Outerwear	<p>Students go outside almost every day. Please send appropriate outerwear.</p> <p>Outerwear is NOT worn in class.</p>	<p>Please send shoes to change into if your student wears snow boots to school.</p> <p>Students also need in-class hoodie/cardigans (see above).</p>
