1. FAFSA Night: Wednesday October 6th from 1830 - 2000 UMA is hosting a FAFSA night. This event is for all seniors, regardless of post high school plans! Please come and fill out the Free application for Federal Student Aid while getting help from experts!

a. FAFSA is needed to apply for and earn scholarships from most colleges. The application is simple and it is free! If you have any intention of attending college this is your first step for assistance! Gather and bring these things:

- i. Student's and parent(s)' Social Security Card (if parent does not have one, that is ok)
- ii. Student's I-9 paperwork or Permanent Resident Card (if the student has one. Typically this applies to refugee or asylee students)
- iii. Student's driver's license (if the student has one)
- iv. Student's and parent(s)' 2019 W-2 forms and other records of taxed income*
- v. Student's and parent(s)' 2019 Federal Income Tax Return**
- vi. Student's and parent(s)' current bank statements
- vii. Student's and parent(s)' 2019 untaxed income records
- viii. Student's and parent(s)' current business and investment, property mortgage information, business and farm, stock, bond, and other investment records***
