### 1. What is a Crew?

a. Our school culture encourages all members, parents and students alike, to become crew, not passengers. This means that students and parents are known well by at least one adult in the school.
Every student is part of a Crew. Every parent is part of a Crew – the Family Crew Organization.

### 2. Who is needed in the FCO?

a. EVERY parent is invited to participate and be an active part in our crew! Our school website states: "All parents and guardians of children enrolled at GreenWood Charter School are automatically considered members of the FCO. Each member is welcomed as a valuable contributor to the mission and goals of the crew. The success of the FCO rests on the commitment and contributions of our parent body."

  - a. Parents can support at Home by daily:
    - i. Reading 20 minutes
    - ii. Practicing math for 10 minutes
    - iii. Eating 5 plants
    - iv. Saying 4 kind words & give hugs
    - v. Sitting down for 3 meals
    - vi. Limiting media to 2 hours
    - vii. Exercising 1 hour outside
    - viii. Drinking water
  - b. Parents can support the School by:
    - Providing service to the school for 30 hours annually; singleparent families are expected to volunteer for 15 hours annually. (see handbook)
