Greenwood Families,

As COVID concerns rise in our community, we want to notify you of the steps that GreenWood is taking to care for our students and staff. We are closely monitoring our COVID infection numbers and are following the State of Utah and Weber-Morgan Health guidelines for in-person and remote learning. We currently are below COVID infection numbers that would require a shift in instruction and while some schools in our community around us have needed to move to remote learning, we are able to staff and teach students in-person. If circumstances change we will notify families of changes and instruction.

We will be taking a few precautionary measures as follows for the next 3 - 4 weeks (or until community case numbers decrease):

- Forest Crew will be held virtually
- Fieldwork will be postponed
- Celebrations of Learning will be postponed
- We will not be holding large group functions
- Students will stay in similar cohorts
- Lunch will be served in the classrooms
- Specials classes and PE will continue to be held outside as much as possible
- The building will continue to be cleaned thoroughly
- Handwashing and hygiene will be encouraged

We are hoping that this will help us to reduce the spread. In addition, if your child has been exposed and asked to wear a mask, we are asking that you help us by encouraging them to do so. We appreciate all of us working together to help everyone feel like we have a safe environment to come to school each day.
