COVID Protocol at Bridge – February 2022

Please Note: These procedures may change based on recommendations from the health department.

MASKS

It is <u>highly encouraged</u> that those who have not been fully vaccinated wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth while at school.

TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID

Under the updated guidelines, anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 must:

- Stay at home for 5 days from the day you were tested, even if you don't have symptoms or feel sick. You can leave your house after 5 days if your symptoms have improved (fever-free without medicine for at least 24 hours and your symptoms have improved). You must stay home for at least 5 days.
- Wear a mask around others for the 5 days after your home isolation. This means students can return to school but MUST wear a mask for five days. If the individual will not, or does not want to, wear a mask, the individual must isolate the entire 10 days.

EXPOSURE TO SOMEONE WITH COVID - QUARANTINE

- If the student or staff member is fully vaccinated, the individual does not need to quarantine at home. However, the individual should wear a mask, including at school, for 10 days after the exposure.
- If the student or staff member is not fully vaccinated, the individual should stay home from school for at least 5 days from the day the student was exposed. The individual can return to school after 5 days if the individual doesn't have any symptoms. The individual should also wear a mask, including at school, for an additional 5 days.
 - o If the student can't stay home from school, the student may attend school but should wear a mask at school during the 10 days after their exposure.

STAY HOME WHEN SICK

Fully vaccinated individuals must stay home when they are ill (fever, cough, intestinal issues, etc. that are not attributable to another disorder). Non-vaccinated individuals must stay home when they have any of the following symptoms: sore throat, fever, cough, headache, or intestinal issues unless a physician has provided a note indicating the symptoms are NOT related to COVID (for example allergies, anxiety, etc.).

CLEANING and SANITIZING

All individuals entering Bridge must sanitize their hands upon entry and either wash their hands or sanitize every hour and also sanitize when entering or leaving a classroom or the lunchroom.

Tables, chairs and supplies must be wiped and sanitized after use BEFORE another individual may use the item(s).

High touch areas such as door handles and handrails MUST be wiped down and sanitized a minimum of every two hours.

VOLUNTEERS – VISITORS

Volunteers or visitors who do not have any COVID symptoms are allowed to visit areas of Bridge Elementary beyond the front office area.
