Mrs. Nelsen led a discussion on many important things we are seeing right now. Here are some bullet points from our conversation:

- We would like to see parents engaging other parents! Come volunteer-meet other parents-become friends-invite other parents of GreenWood to come volunteer, too! This is why we started the Park Playdates every 2nd and 4th Friday of the month! Come and meet other parents!!
- Administration and teachers here have policies in place to have open communication with parents. These look like SLC's, Family Activities, Monthly Parent (FCO) Meetings, Fieldwork opportunities, volunteer opportunities, emailing between teachers/parents, scheduled one-on-one meetings between teachers/parents when needed.
- What are the barriers and roadblocks that are keeping parents from volunteering? (some barriers mentioned were: some activities have been disorganized; too many volunteers show up/not enough volunteers show up; some parents are single parents or working parents or have other scheduling conflicts that make it difficult to volunteer during school hours). We understand that sometimes these barriers are out of our control to fix, but if there is something we can do to fix it, we would like to! But first we have to know about it! And then when we know about, we appreciate your patience as we figure it out and practice at getting better at these things on our end :)
- We would like to know if there are more partnerships we can build in our community. Please let us know if you have any suggestions!
- How can we get more parents to attend our parent meeting? These really are the best way to give Mrs. Nelsen direct feedback and have a group discussion! What are the barriers here? Is it the time? Would it help to have a Zoom only evening meeting as well as the in-person morning meetings? Is there a different time other than 9:00 that would work better? One important shift we are making with these meetings is to have them be less about what you can do for us and more about what we can do for you and your child. PLEASE, we would LOVE your feedback!
