D. Public Comment

- 1. Felicia Widger and Nelson Fresses addressed the Board about concerns regarding their student at PODER
 - a. Told "there are enough parents attending the field trip" so they were not permitted to attend. They would like this resolved.
 - b. They also seek a resolution to a disciplinary issue regarding their student. Do not feel it was addressed adequately with the staff.

E. School Updates

- 1. WY-TOPP professional development underway
 - a. Projecting good results
- 2. Tennis season
 - a. Certain gym activities will be reimbursed from COVID relief funds
- 3. Preparing to open gym facility to the public
 - a. \$50 for 90 minutes
 - b. Starting in the fall of 2022
- 4. MAPS testing will follow WY-TOPP
- 5. Projecting high enrollment for next year
 - a. Will hold lottery
 - b. Siblings get priority
 - c. Carlos: how many kids have applied so far?
 - i. Marcos: About 40 or so students for kinder, waitlists then get smaller as grade levels get higher

F. Financials Oversight (through Jan. 31^{st,} 2022)

- 1. Marcos finances are healthy
 - a. Looking to shore up balance sheet, utilize COVID relief funds as much as possible
 - b. Adding a 6th grade at PODER will add to revenue
 - i. May take a few years for new revenue stream to make an impact
- 2. Bob: Very concerned about deficits and negative deviations
 - a. Financial snapshots do not reflect a balanced budget

- b. Marcos: Financial snapshots will show a more accurate picture by the end of the year after expected reimbursements come in. The timing in the year is a factor, lots of money going out, not much coming in due to financial cycles.
- c. Bob: Board requests updated financial snapshots
- d. Marcos: Assures Board that deficits will be rectified once all reimbursements come in
- 3. Marcos: Audit will better reflect school's finances
- 4. Bob: PODER is below recommended funding for continued operations
 - a. Marcos: not a huge concern, very close to goal and not likely that funding will cease unexpectedly
- 5. Yara: Is PODER allowed to charge for enrollment?
 - a. Marcos: No, PODER is currently a public school
 - i. Can only charge for uniforms and other service fees
- 6. Carlos: Also requests that snapshots are more current when the Board meets
 - a. Marcos will put in that request
- 7. Carlos motion to approve the financials (7:30); approved unanimous

 - a. Board nominates Yara
