





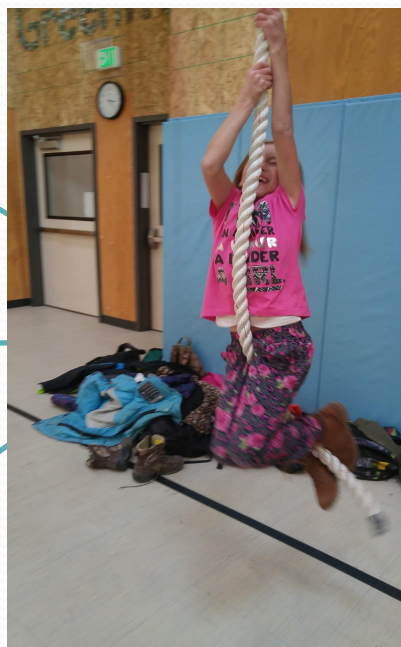

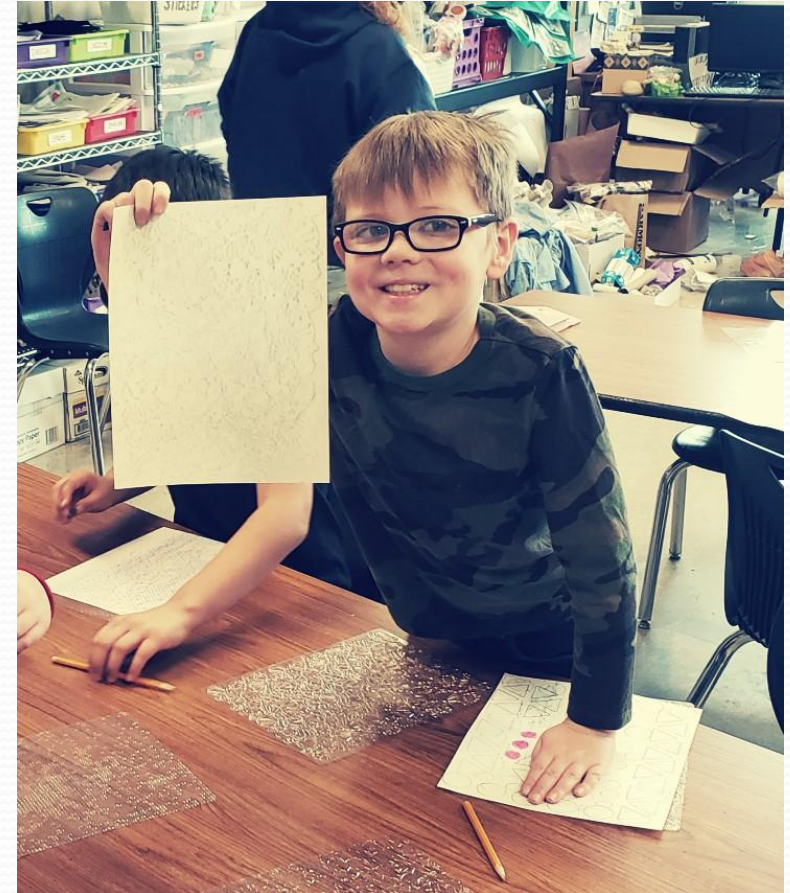
GreenWood Family Expectations

- **Full Family Support** of GW Healthy Habits including lunches/snacks, celebrations & birthdays
- **Active Dress**- capped sleeves, shoes to run in, no hats or heely shoes indoors, shorts within 2-3 inches of knee, wear green on Friday!
- **Every Minute Matters**: Arrive by 8:15am, avoid early check-outs! Crew time is important!
- Students set academic and behavior **GOALS** and **celebrate** our learning with our families.



Homework Expectations

- 20 minutes of reading every night with a family member
- 10 minutes of math fact practice in the car to and from school
- Limit media to 2 hours/day
- Parent check-in and reflection



How do I know my student is growing?

KEEP - KINDERGARTEN ENTRY AND EXIT PROFILE

- Given by Kindergarten Teacher the first and last week of school. The Kindergarten Teacher will schedule a time with you at Back to School Night
- Given twice a year
- Informs teachers and parents academic skills of entering and exiting kindergarten students

ACADIENCE Reading & Math

- Given three times a year.
- Informs students, teachers, and parents the reading development and growth of K-6 students
- Informs students, teachers and parents the math development and growth of 2-3 grade students

RISE

- End of year assessments given in Math, Reading, Writing, and Science
- Informs students, teachers, and parents the proficiency and growth of 3-8 students

JUMPROPE

- Jumprope is our gradebook. Students and families will have access to login and see student's grades, missing assignments, and teacher contact information.

We will share with you at Student-Led Conference and Celebrations of Learning, the growth of students in Mastery of Skill and Knowledge, Character, and High Quality Work.
