<b>Pencil Sharpener</b>	Small handheld, portable, pencil sharpeners, not battery operated	<b>Pencils (24 count or more)</b>	Ticonderoga if possible; these sharpen well, don't break as easily, and their erasers last longer. Pre-sharpened would be great, but not necessary.
<b>Colored Pencils (12 ct)</b>	Please buy the Crayola brand for all these coloring tools; this brand holds up well to usage, sharpening, and has the best and brightest color and texture for the price.	<b>Expo Markers (multi-count pack, black, fine tip)</b>	We use these during math and writing on personal white boards.
<b>Crayons (24 ct)</b>		<b>Sharpies</b>	2 Regular Fine Tip, black 2 Ultra Fine Tip, black
<b>Markers (10 ct)</b>		<b>Glue Sticks</b>	3 or more small glue sticks, Elmer brand
		<b>Erasers</b>	Either a pack of pencil top erasers or block erasers
<b>Pencil Bag</b>	Big enough to hold all the above mentioned items, roughly 7 ½ inches by 10 inches. Please no boxes.	<b>Paper Towels</b>	1 roll
<b>Reusable Water Bottles</b>	The bottle should have a good, leak-proof lid. This helps keep our trips to the drinking fountain to a minimum.	<b>Kleenex (facial tissues)</b>	1 or more boxes
<b>Earbuds or Headphones</b>	These are used almost on a daily basis, please send your child to school with either earbuds or headphones, whichever they would prefer.	<b>Hand Sanitizer</b>	1 8 ounce bottle
