These guidelines are used by schools, institutions, and facilities participating in the National School Lunch Program (and USDA Foods School Program), School Breakfast Program, Special Milk Program for Children, Child and Adult Care Food Program, Summer Food Service Program and The Emergency Food Assistance Program and are effective from July 1 through June 30 every year.
